**Preposition**

A **preposition** is a word that shows the **relationship** between a noun or pronoun and other words in a sentence.

Example:

- The book is **on** the table.
- The cat is **under** the chair.

**Prepositions of Time**

Prepositions of time tell us when something happens. The prepositions of time are **in, on, at**.

**IN** → longer periods of time (months, years, centuries, parts of the day, seasons)

- in the morning
- in July
- in 2020
- in winter

**ON** → specific days and dates

- on Monday
- on Christmas Day
- on 5th June
- on my birthday

**AT** → exact time or short moments

- at 7 o'clock
- at noon / at night
- at the moment
- at sunrise
