These categories allow for structured, meaningful communication and can vary by context.

<b>Noun</b> Refers to a person, concept, place, or thing	<b>Pronoun</b> Used in place of a noun
<b>Adjective</b> Modifies a noun or pronoun	<b>Adverb</b> Can modify a verb, adjective, adverb, or whole sentence
<b>Verb</b> Describes an action, occurrence, or state of being	<b>Preposition</b> Used to show the relationship between the different parts of a sentence
<b>Conjunction</b> Connects different parts of a sentence	<b>Interjection</b> Used in isolation to express a feeling, give a command, or greet someone
