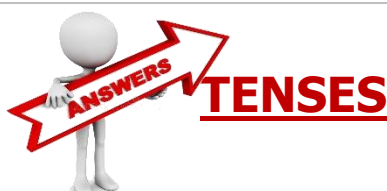

Identify the kinds of tenses used in the following sentences.

1. Does he exercise every morning?

Ans: Simple Present Tense (Interrogative form)

2. Ravi was listening to music while I was studying.

Ans: Past Continuous Tense

3. Sarah is not feeling well today.

Ans: Present Continuous Tense (Negative form)

4. The school bell rang at 7 o'clock.

Ans: Simple Past Tense

5. People were waiting for the ticket counter to open.

Ans: Past Continuous Tense

6. Are you joining us for the picnic this Sunday?

Ans: Present Continuous Tense (used for planned future)

7. He bought some good books from the book fair.

Ans: Simple Past Tense

8. Isha won't be attending the convocation tomorrow.

Ans: Future Continuous Tense (Negative form)

9. Did she pick up the parcel from the post office?

Ans: Simple Past Tense (Interrogative form)

10. They do not play cricket on Sundays.

Ans: Simple Present Tense (Negative form)



EXERCISE 2:

Change the tenses of the following sentences, as directed:

1. He passed the examination without any difficulty.

Ans: He will pass the examination without any difficulty. (Simple Future)

2. They are cleaning their room.

Ans: They will be cleaning their room. (Future Continuous)

3. The dog barks loudly.

Ans: The dog barked loudly. (Simple Past)

4. He will present his research at the conference.

Ans: He presented his research at the conference. (Simple Past)

5. The children played in the rain.

Ans: The children are playing in the rain. (Present Continuous)

6. Joe will be reading a novel.

Ans: Joe read a novel. (Simple Past)

7. They were working on the sculpture all afternoon.

Ans: They worked on the sculpture all afternoon. (Simple Past)

8. They will go to the zoo next week.

Ans: They will be going to the zoo next week. (Future Continuous)

9. The students will submit their projects tomorrow.

Ans: The students submitted their projects. (Simple Past)

10. She will bake a cake for the party.

Ans: She was baking a cake for the party. (Past Continuous)
